As a clinician, teacher, and researcher, I strive to share my clinical expertise and current research perspective with speech-language pathologists to help them feel more confident and competent in their skills for helping people who stutter. I have served on the board of directors of the National Stuttering Association (NSA), as well as on the Steering Committee of the ASHA Special Interest Division for Fluency Disorders. I received the Dean's Distinguished Teaching Award in the School of Health and Rehabilitation Sciences at the University of Pittsburgh. In 2006, I was named an ASHA Fellow. In 2009, I was named Speech-Language Pathologist of the Year and in 2019 named to the Hall of Fame by the National Stuttering Association. And, in 2012, I received the Annie Glenn National Leadership Award from the Ohio Speech Pathology Educational Audiology Coalition.
