BMS CHEERLEADING TRYOUTS INFORMATION AND RULES

-Cheerleading Tryout Clinic: Wednesday through Friday, April 26th through 28th, 2023 3:15-4:30 in the MS/Elementary gym.

-Each day is REQUIRED in order for the student to try out for the cheerleading team on the official tryout day of FRIDAY, APRIL 28TH.

-ALL clinic days and official tryout day (APRIL 28TH) are closed to the public. ONLY those trying out will be permitted in the gymnasium each day.

-Students must be academically eligible to try out. -Try out participants are not required to create an original cheer or routine. Participants will be taught required cheer material and the fight song to be performed on the day of the try out. Attendants will also perform tumbling and jumping skills. Video of the fight song will be emailed to you by MONDAY, APRIL 17TH.

-Students will receive randomly chosen numbers determining their order in trying out.

-Participants are required to wear a plain white t-shirt and black shorts, hair up in a ponytail and appropriate footwear when trying out on FRIDAY, APRIL 28TH.

-EACH day of clinic, participants are required to wear shorts or leggings, t-shirts, and appropriate footwear. If they aren't in appropriate dress, they will not be permitted to practice during that day of clinic and will sit out.
