

# Bethany High School Re-Entry Plan

## 2020-2021

### Arrival Time

- Masks will be required for all staff and students in school buildings (2-ply masks).
- All staff and students will have their temperature taken as they enter the building. Anyone with 100.4 or higher will not be allowed to enter the building
- The doors will open at 7:30 am only for students eating breakfast. To help with social distancing, we would like other students to wait until 7:45 to enter the building. Students who walk will also have to wait to enter the building at 7:45 am. Please make arrangements now if you have been dependent on an earlier arrival time.
- Entrances
  - All HS students will enter through the West entrance for temperature checks.
  - If students are involved in any extracurricular activities such as band or orchestra, those teachers will provide information on different times, entrances, and temperature checks.

### Lunch

- For students eating in the cafeteria, limits will be set on the number of people at a table, booth, and social distancing will be encouraged at all times.
- Eating arrangements will be evaluated on a regular basis.

### Masks/Mitigation Strategies

- The foundation for healthy kids at school will be keeping sick kids at home. If your child is symptomatic in any way (cough, fever, upset stomach), keep them at home.
- Students and staff will use hand sanitizer upon entrance and exit of each classroom.
- We will take the temperature of all students as they enter the schools. Staff will take their temperature when they sign in each day.
- Masks are required for students, staff and volunteers while inside school facilities.
- Masks must be multiple layered cloth.
- The school will provide a mask if the student does not have one.
- The principal has final authority on whether a mask is appropriate.

- Neck gaiters must have multiple layers to meet acceptable mask criteria.
- The only exception for wearing a mask in all Bethany Public School buildings is a note from a physician on physician letterhead.
- Teachers may present lessons in a face shield.
- Face shields will be purchased for any staff member that wants to use one.
- We will encourage social distancing whenever possible.
- Visitors and volunteers are required to wear a mask.

### Specials (Band, Orchestra, and Vocal)

- Teachers and administration will be in constant contact to ensure safety is the highest priority, while still providing the opportunity for students to participate in things in which they are passionate.

### Social Distancing

- Social Distancing will be expected when space allows. Teachers and administration will consistently communicate with students about how to maintain social distancing and the importance of it

### Restrooms

- Restrooms will be cleaned and sanitized many times throughout the day. Students will be asked to wash and/or sanitize their hands each time they leave or enter the classroom.

### Visitors

- Visitors and volunteers will only be allowed to enter the building to speak with office staff or volunteer in the workroom. In the event that a visitor needs to enter the building, their temperature will be taken at the door and they will be required to wear a mask at all times. Visitors will not be able to interact with other students including visiting classrooms or eating in the cafeteria.

### Dismissal

- When school is dismissed at 3:00pm, students will exit the building immediately.

### Athletic Plan

- A plan for athletics will be released as soon as it becomes available

## Positive Test Response

- When a student is lab tested and confirmed to have COVID-19, all students sitting within 6 feet for 15 minutes or longer will be sent home for a 14 - day quarantine.
- The school will contact all parents of students to be quarantined.
- Free COVID-19 tests are given at the West Clinic 4330 NW 10th St OKC, OK. Open Monday – Friday 8:00am to 4:30pm Phone number: 405-419-4150
- The school will contact parents of students that have been in a close proximity of exposure when we have a positive COVID-19 test.
- We will only close entire school and begin distance learning for everyone when advised to do so by the county health department or other state agency.
